HOW AND WHY KIDS
CHANGE THE WORLD

- Dream Tank and Dream Makers launched a plastic ban campaign with a Colorado State Representative
- Dream Tank and Ascension VR developing an AI + VR game to help veterans with PTSD
- Dream Tank and Dream Makers co-sponsored and testified for a bill that was ultimately passed to legalize minors' businesses in Colorado
- DreamMakers share their ideas with the Mayor of Boulder, CO
- Helyn, age 9, created a design for a kinetic battery that attaches to gym equipment
- Nick, a Dream Tank fellow, created a solution for paralysis victims to control their hands and arms with their minds
- Carina, 8 designed a 'cuff' for endangered animals such as orangutans, to warn them when threats to their lives are nearby
- Jesus & Eduardo, 9 and 11, created a way for Minecraft players to donate to their local hospital

Global Game Mission: Save lives of Veterans with Tech

Hacking 4 Heroes - Entrepreneurial, mission driven kids and teens ages 7-18, their families, and local veterans held a series of hackathons sponsored by Debi Stack, a female Fortune 100 executive with extensive AI, VR and AR experience. The kids and teens are currently building a game called "Rediscover Joy"













Two of our Dream Makers, Anya Smith and Summer Cuppari Gould (then 10 and 11), the Story Architects, heard a local Owl Preserve was in danger of being demolished to build 300 affordable homes. They found that the housing development could be located elsewhere close by, and spare this beautiful land and hunting ground for Great Horned Owls. The two were invited by the Boulder Owl Preserve organization to create an inspiring and fun documentary to bring decision makers an owls' perspective. They partnered with Dream Tank, Andrew Ackerman of Off the Map Media and Exposure Lab / Jeff Orlowski (Chasing Ice & Chasing Coral), and brought the owls spirit to life in a 4-minute video, partially filmed with a drone. Dream Tank invited other DreamMakers to explore how their businesses and voices could contribute to the cause. Five other DreamMakers joined the Story Architects, Anya and Summer, at Boulder Valley School District's (BVSD) February School Board Public Owl Hearing, to ask them to vote to save the Owls. One DreamMaker offered to design a new Owl Preserve using Minecraft as inspiration for an innovative design process. As a result of the Dream Makers presentations and videos, among a few other factors, they voted to preserve the land and halt development. It was a huge success.




